1. **ATTENDANCE AND APOLOGIES:** As above.

- 2. POLICE AND CRIME PREVENTION ISSUES: Dedicated officer confirmed as PC Sharon McPeake. // Crime figures (1st May to date) Dennistoun South: 71 total, 49 detected, vandalism, theft, crimes of dishonesty, drugs; Dennistoun North: 91 total, 38 detected, some housebreaking, but reduced due to a recent imprisonment, arrests have been made for two common assaults. // A higher proportion of fraud crime that usual. // Working with Milnbank HA arrest made regarding drugs. // Info requested on hotspot areas, especially with school holidays approaching (eg off-sales, Armadale Path) info to GreaterGlasgowLondonRdPerfSupport@scotland.pnn.police.uk. // Warning note given about 'distraction crimes' by a known group of three female suspects ('Eastern European, 20-30, 1 x heavy build, 2 x thin') in vicinity of Celino's. // Missing persons an issue at present. // Michelle asked if dog theft was known as a key issue, but police responded that it was not a noted issue at present. // Taxi drivers sounding horns on Hillfoot St raised by Stephen. Acknowledged as a repeat issue (Hampden Cars cited), but it has only been reported by one person, so difficult to take much action. Cllr Docherty pointed out that refraining from misuse of horns is a condition of licence.
- 3. **PUBLIC INPUT:** None.
- 4. **MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON 12/5/15:** No amendments requested. Proposed by WW, seconded by BJ.
- 5. **MATTERS ARISING:** a) <u>Basketball court recommissioning:</u> SB, MM & AM met as the Big Lunch working group and approached Reidvale HA, with a positive response. Other parties are on board, too. B-ball court + Clean-up + Big Lunch + extra events planned for date TBC (possibly 2nd or 3rd Sat in July. A new Big Lunch fund of £150 is available for new groups. // b) <u>Barnardo's:</u> Letter sent. Invitation to attend is open. // c) <u>Parking:</u> Comments on footway parking on Broompark Drive and Clayton Terrace have been circulated to interested parties. // d) <u>Friends of Alexandra Park:</u> Meeting on Wednesday 17th June in Sports Hub (at bowling green) in Alexandra Park. // e) <u>Offer of old photos:</u> Contact made but correspondence has gone cold.

- 6. **ACTION PLAN:** a) <u>Arts focus group:</u> Caitlin to arrange a focus group meeting to discuss arts items on the action plan. // b) <u>Environment focus group:</u> Angela not present (see also AOB). // c) <u>Events focus group:</u> Frank P not present. Cllr Docherty noted an offer from Edzell to contribute to the Big Lunch, whether held in or outwith Buffalo Bill Square. It was agreed that DCC would host a stall at Alexandra Park Festival on 25th July stall details TBC. // d) <u>Dennistoun Billboard Project:</u> Seeking funding from Create Scotland, Lottery, etc to total £15k. Artists have been contacted. Stephen to co-ordinate historical info. Planned for first week in October. // e) <u>Day Out in Dennistoun:</u> Launch at Alexandra Park Festival proposed. Andy to be contacted to arrange closure. Draft map to be re-circulated for comment. // f) <u>Duke Street Project:</u> The group has met. Notes to be circulated. Consultation to be progressed during the summer. // g) <u>Communications working group</u>: Mike not present. Meeting to be convened to discuss.
