- When you have completed the sheet, please hand it in to your teacher.
- Remember to put your name, class and school. Every child who hands in a form with answers will get a certificate.
- There will be two main prizes for each school: one £25 book voucher for the boy and the girl with the most correct answers from each school. If there is more than one sheet with all the answers right, the winners will be based on the tie-breaker chosen by Dennistoun Community Council. We'll let the school know who won prizes during the week starting Monday October 3rd, and you can collect it from your teacher.
- Younger children should be with their parents while looking at the shop windows, and everyone should only cross Duke Street at the proper crossings.
