



## THE 2012 DENNISTOUN TREASURE HUNT

- From Tuesday September 18<sup>th</sup>, until the morning of Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup>, each of the shops named on the other side of this sheet will have a Moshi Monster in their window display.
- Write down the Monster's name after the shop name on the other side of this sheet. All the Monsters can be seen in the shop windows, so please don't bother people working in the shops.
- We also want you to let us know what you think about Dennistoun. If you're in Primary 1, 2, 3, and 4 please tell us what's good about Dennistoun. If you're in Primary 5, 6, and 7 we want to know what Dennistoun needs. If there are lots of correct entries the best answer will help decide the winner.
- When you have completed the sheet, please hand it in to your teacher. Entry forms collected from schools on Thursday September 27<sup>th</sup>.
- Remember to put your name, class and school. Every child who hands in a form with answers will get a certificate.
- There will be two main prizes for each school: one £25 WHSmith voucher for the boy and the girl with the most correct answers from each school. If there is more than one sheet with all the answers right, the winners will be based on the tie-breaker chosen by Dennistoun Community Council. We'll let the school know who won prizes (with details of the prizegiving) during the week starting Monday October 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Younger children should be with their parents while looking at the shop windows, and everyone should only cross Duke Street at the proper crossings.
- Note to parents - Please note this is supposed to be a fun event for children. While we understand younger children will need some help, participating shops will not respond to phone calls asking what Monster they have in the window.
- As the success rate has been very high in previous years, we've made the Treasure Hunt a little harder this year. Don't worry if you can't name every Moshi, we don't think many people will.
- We reserve the right to disqualify any entry we believe to have been completed entirely by adults. The decision of Dennistoun Community Council regarding winning entries is final, and no correspondence will be entered into. There will be no cash alternatives to the prizes offered.
