



## **THE 2012 DENNISTOUN TREASURE HUNT**

### **TEACHER SHEET**

- From Tuesday September 18<sup>th</sup>, until the morning of Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup>, each of the shops named on the entry form sheet will have a Moshi Monster in the window. The children should write down which Monster is in which shop window after the shop name on the entry sheet list.  
All Monsters will be seen in the shop windows, so please ask the children not to bother people working in the shops.
- Additionally the children will be asked to let us know what they think about Dennistoun as a tie break. There is space for this on the form.
- When the sheet has been completed, it should be handed back in to the class teacher. All sheets should have the name, class, teacher and school boxes filled in. Entry forms collected from schools on Thursday September 27<sup>th</sup>.
- Every child who hands in a form with answers will get a certificate.  
We have supplied certificates to the school, so could you please fill in the child's name when they hand in a completed form, and present them with a certificate.
- There will be two main prizes for each school: one £25 WHSmith voucher for the boy and the girl with the most correct answers from each school.
- If there is more than one sheet with all the answers right, the winners will be based on the tie-breaker chosen by Dennistoun Community Council shortly after the forms have been collected. We'll let the school know the prize winners and pass the vouchers to the appropriate teachers during the week starting Monday October 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Younger children should be with their parents or older brothers and sisters while looking at the shop windows, and everyone should only cross Duke Street at the proper crossings.
- As the success rate has been very high in previous years, the Treasure Hunt has been made a little harder this year. Don't worry if you can't name every Moshi, we don't think many people will.
