to Games venues, Road Race routes or live
sites may be affected in particular, and it is

From 24 to 29 July, two sessions per day will be held from 10.30 to 19.00.

Up to 7,400 spectators will arrive and depart throughout the day to watch the competitions.

Gates open 90 minutes before sessions begin.

Road Courses: impact on travel

Look out for the fast, fun and free-to-view action on closed city streets:

- Marathon: Sunday 27 July 2014
- Cycling Time Trial: Thursday 31 July 2014
- Cycling Road Race: Sunday 3 August 2014

Traffic management measures will be in place to allow competition to take place and keep traffic flowing around the city, so plan your Games Time travel in advance.
