Election Meeting

Should 2 or less nominations be received by the closing date, the uncontested election meeting will take place on Tuesday 13th January 2015 and will begin at 7.00pm in Gingerbread Hall, 128 Armadale Street

Contested Election

If more than 2 nominations are received by the closing date then a secret ballot will take place on a date to be confirmed in Gingerbread Hall commencing at 5.30pm and finishing at 8.30pm.

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3. All persons aged over 16 years and resident in the community council area are entitled to vote in elections.
 4. All proposers and seconders must also be resident in the community council area and aged over 16 years.
 5. Candidates, proposers and seconders names should appear on either the Electoral Register or a Supplementary List.

An application form to be included on a Supplementary List may be obtained from Democratic Services, telephone 0141 287 0060.

The application form must be returned with the necessary proof of residency e.g. Council Tax notice, driving licence, recent utility bills, ideally photographic and/or signature evidence etc., and no later than 12 noon on Tuesday 6th January 2015.

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6. If you submit a Nomination Form, Democratic Services will contact you in writing to confirm the validity of your nomination and will inform you at the close of nominations if a contested election will take place.
