3 Chair overview of council resilience

- Lack of PPE a real issue.
- Social care a key concern.
- Redeployment of staff to other services is a live issue being looked at.

4 Discussion on COVID19 outbreak and DCC support

- LB noted potential of DCC to assist with existing local volunteer activities and support groups (e.g. Covid 19 Support Glasgow North East group).
- ED summarised correspondence received by DCC (in particular a specific request for drivers).
- DH identified some issues related to a territorial approach.
- LB noted that a support mechanism in Dennistoun and Haghill is lacking, especially in areas not well covered by HAs.
- The Freedom Cafe and Everlasting Foodbank noted as a critical player in Dennistoun.
- Development Trusts, for example, can apply for funding. Can Community Councils do so in the same way (as a standalone DCC application, or on behalf of a local partner group)?
- LB will forward some funding details for review.

- If DCC is to apply in this manner, we will need to meet again.

- Written update from ED:
 - <u>From BJ</u>: Planning there are no significant Planning issues to be addressed. I am not sure how the Planning process is functioning but they continue to email the details of Applications. Licensing The Community Council Development Session on 21st March did not take place due to the current issues and, as far as I am aware, there are no current issues in this respect.

- <u>From RJ</u>: I haven't got a DAP report as there hasn't been a meeting since the last DCC meeting and probably wont be any for the foreseeable future.
- <u>From SGN</u>: From Tuesday 24 March, we are only continuing with safety-critical and emergency work. This means we'll temporarily suspend our planned gas holder dismantling work in Provan.
- <u>Re ACP Proposal</u>: Given the current COVID-19 outbreak, Glasgow Airport has made the decision to pause its Airspace Change Proposal programme until further notice. We will continue to monitor the situation and once we have a clear indication of timetabled engagement activities we shall contact you again to discuss our next steps.
- <u>Elections</u>: Nothing on the GCC website yet (several CC elections which ended in March are still showing). I've emailed Lawrence for an update.
