1 Welcome/Introductions/Attendance/Apologies

2 Presentation/Q&A with Ian Elder, Development and Regeneration Services, GCC

Phase three of the District Regeneration Frameworks has commenced, taking in Cowcaddens, Townhead, Learning Quarter (which includes some of the DCC area) and Merchant City (which adjoins with the DCC area). IE described the principles and approaches. A consultation has fed into mapping and analysis. Approximately two-thirds of residential population of the City Centre is in these North and East areas. Resilience in terms of a response to Covid has been noted in more recent angagement. Progress is intended to be a two-way dialogue, with benefits along the way arising from this dialogue. JD noted the potential to hold a hustings in May. Plans may go ahead as per the previous election, i.e. a planned by a small working group, with additional input brought in as required.

The Herald newspaper have free copies to distribute, but available channels for this are scant.

RJ updated on Friends of Glasgow Necropolis news - Monteath Mausoleum surveyed by Strathclyde University, and funds are being raised to carry out resoration work. Polish consulate funding is in place for restoration of a monument to a Polish soldier. 15th Anniversary edition of FoGN *"Afterlives"* book has been published. More via glasgownecropolis.org.

RJ updated on Friends of Glasgow Royal Infirmary news – Funding is in place for three monuments to nurses/auxiliary workers and further research. Museum space is being set up in association with FoGN. More via friendsofgri.org.

DH passed on thanks from Glasgow Saints for contribution to the craft bags project. Over 200 packs already distributed.

Dennistoun Area Partnership have a delegated authority for issuing funds up to £500.
