<u>Election Questionnaire</u>	
- Question: How will you guarantee the future of Whitehill Pool? (500 word limit).

 <u>Cllr Recruitment/October Elections AGM</u>	
- All Cllrs are required to stand down and re-stand for election in October.	
- We will promote in advance via posters, Dennistoun Information page on facebook, NextDoor site, etc.	
- The minimum number of Community Councillors is 10; the absolute maximum number of Community Councillors for an established Community Council is 20. 10, 11 or 12 requires a quorum of 4; 13, 14 or 15 requires a quorum of 5; 16, 17 or 18 requires a quorum of 6; 19 or 20 requires a quorum of 7. No intention at present to change membership from current level of 17.	
 <u>Future Of DCC Meetings</u>	
- Future meetings fully in-person, fully online; or hybrid? General preference for in-person but only if the venue is of a sufficient size to accommodate social distancing.	
- Re-try Reidvale in May, test Wi-Fi, then judge viability of holding future hybrid meetings, and whether we wish to invest in conference mic/speaker.	
- Options for proposed type of kit discussed, with link to examples circulated to Cllrs.
