2 **Dennistoun Area Partnership**

- Representation of non-CC organisations on the AP is sought. Deadline 17th April.
- Only 1 out of a possible 4 CCs has representation on the AP, due to inactive Ccs.
- Citizens Panels have been mooted as a possible solution, but the details on this are unclear.
- The possibility exists of suggested items being added to the AP agenda, if requested through a Cllr. Might be worth attempting to resolve the uncertainty regarding the uncertain status of various schemes with overlapping aims: Restricted Parking (and 20 mph?) Zone / TRO to formalise the 'Neighbourhood Interventions' (one ways + areas outside schools) / 'Streets for People' proposals consultation (following on from the Liveable Neighbourhoods reports) / implementation of Pavement Parking ban.

- A meeting with the Glasgow Life neighbourhood officer would be a good opportunity for promotion.
- 'Dennistoun in Bloom' also mentioned as a project with promotion opportunities. Dennistoun Diggers may be interested.
- Consultations could be better promoted.

4 **Parks and Open Spaces Fund**

- Update circulated by RJ.
- Japanese Knotweed and Ash Dieback are concerns on various local greenspace sites.

Neighbourhood Infrastructure Improvement Fund Options

- Accessibility/step-free access/pedestrian improvements seen as desirable. E.g. Railway stations, Ark Lane (Broompark to Duke Street), Firpark Street.
- Suggestion of request for new pedestrian crossings. WW + IS to start with identification of locations and seeking advocacy/support respectively.
