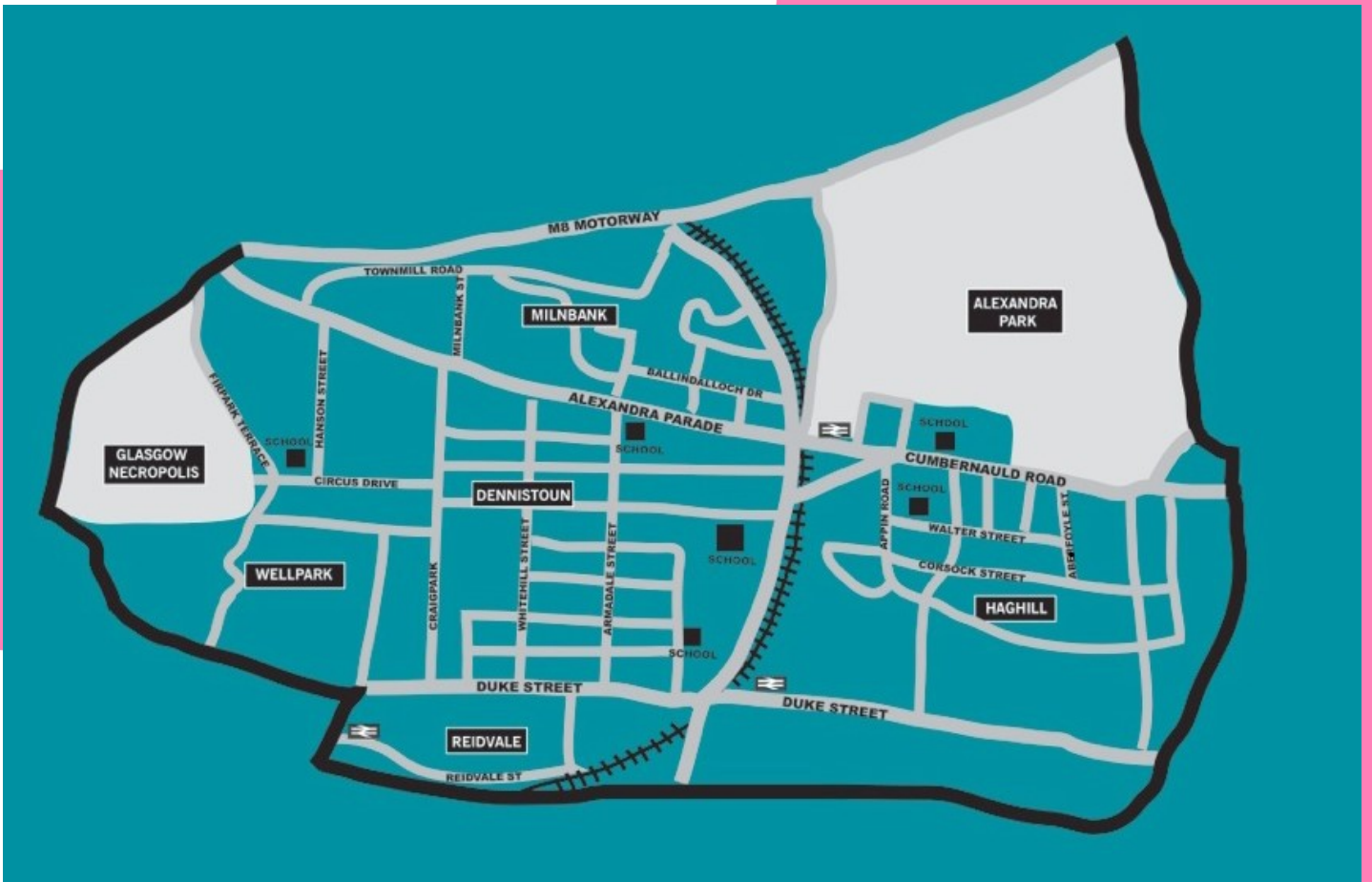




Dennistoun Community Council

Aims

- Ascertain, coordinate and express the views of our community.
- Promote Dennistoun as a positive and inclusive neighbourhood.
- Engage in local issues regarding planning and development, quality and improvement of local services, facilities and amenities, crime and community safety.
- Hold nine meetings every year, attended by local residents, Councillors, MSPs, MPs, and Police Scotland.



Structure + Membership

- Community councils form the most local tier of statutory representation in Scotland.
- Every four years all Councillors are required to stand for re-election alongside any new candidates.
- Office-bearers step down at the Annual General Meeting (AGM) held in October each year.
- DCC membership is currently 15 community councillors (5 office-bearers and up to 10 other Councillors).

Impartiality + Transparency

- DCC is a cohesive and productive group of community volunteers.
- All community council activities are non-party political.
- Anyone can suggest items for discussion by contacting DCC at least a week prior to the meeting. Agendas are published one week prior to the meeting taking place.
- Minutes are presented for approval at the following meeting. When approved, they are the formal record of past meetings and are published online.
